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

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



Medical Decision Making: Patient presents with his DHS caseworker for evaluation of possible medical nutritional neglect. Patient is small for stated age but other wise is well-appearing on examination. His lungs are clear to auscultation throughout. There is no increased work of breathing noted heart is regular rate and rhythm without murmur. Abdomen is soft nontender nondistended. DHS caseworker was given instructions to contact the child advocacy center on January 13, 2022 schedule a follow-up appointment. Detailed instructions given for symptoms to monitor for that would indicate need to return for further evaluation. Parents questions were answered and they were agreeable with the plan of care.
